

BEET PULP, PRESSED

DESCRIPTION:

Beet Pulp is the vegetable matter that remains after sugar is extracted from sliced sugar beets. It is bulk feed, high in fiber and unique in that its fiber is extremely digestible.

Feeding and Usage

Dried Beet Pulp can be included in dairy rations at up to 7-15 % of daily ration depending on other feedstuffs available. In beef rations Dried Beet Pulp can be fed at 15-20% of the total ration. Horses can be fed 20-40 % of the ration as Beet Pulp. With all classes of livestock, care must be taken to balance the vitamin and mineral needs.

Storage and Handling

Beet Pulp is available in bulk. Bulk material is delivered in dump or live bottom trailers with each truckload containing about 25 tons. It can be handled with normal equipment used in the feed or grain industry.
